ANZAC BISCUITS (iconic PWMU recipe)

1 cup rolled oats	2 tablespoon boiling water
1 cup flour	3/4 cup dessicated coconut
3/4 cup sugar	1/2 teaspoon bicarb soda
1/2 cup melted butter	2 tablespoons golden syrup

Preheat oven to 160 degrees C. Combine oats, flour, coconut & sugar. Dissolve the soda in boiling water, add melted butter & golden syrup. Pour into the dry ingredients & mix well. Place teaspoonfuls on baking tray. Bake for 15 minutes or until golden brown.

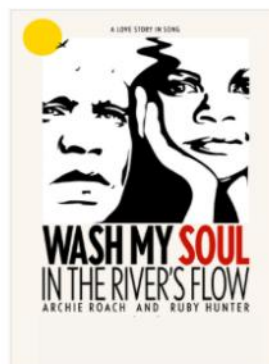

Lismore Browns Waterholes Under-highway Footbridge Opening and Discovery Trail links



The footbridge, unusable for maybe 3 years, has been replaced with a wider firmer structure, thanks to the work of the Shire and funding from the Corangamite Shire, GPG Berrybank Windfarms and the Victorian Government Tiny Towns project.

The footbridge allows people to cross under the highway to connect the north and south sides of the town safely near the swimming pool and the train.

The 'new' footbridge was officially opened last Sunday 21st June with approx 50 people attending. The formalities included a Welcome to Country from Auntie Kellie a Wadawurrung Elder, and encouraging speeches from the Mayor Kate Makin and our local councillor Nick Cole. We were treated to very fine food from Fairway Café and Full on Food, with our local SES providing the power and hosting the serving of goods and tea and coffee. Thank you to Bec Reedman and her Shire team.

Following the official opening the Lismore Heart Health Walking Group was joined by others as they walked to the cemetery and back. They were met by Cemetery Trustee Avon Buchholz who gave them a guided tour of the site which included stories of the town's past residents and experiencing the new nature walk. Other community members visited the old Bluestone Presbyterian Church. They were able to go into the building and learn more of its history from local history enthusiast Andrew Lang



The Lismore Discovery Trail can now be walked in full using the new foot bridge. The final information post has been installed outside the Presbyterian Church. Thank you to the Men's Shed for constructing the information post, to Andrew Lang for helping to secure the well seasoned locally grown (Scarsdale) cypress used in the post, and to members of the Progress Association and Men's shed for installing it.

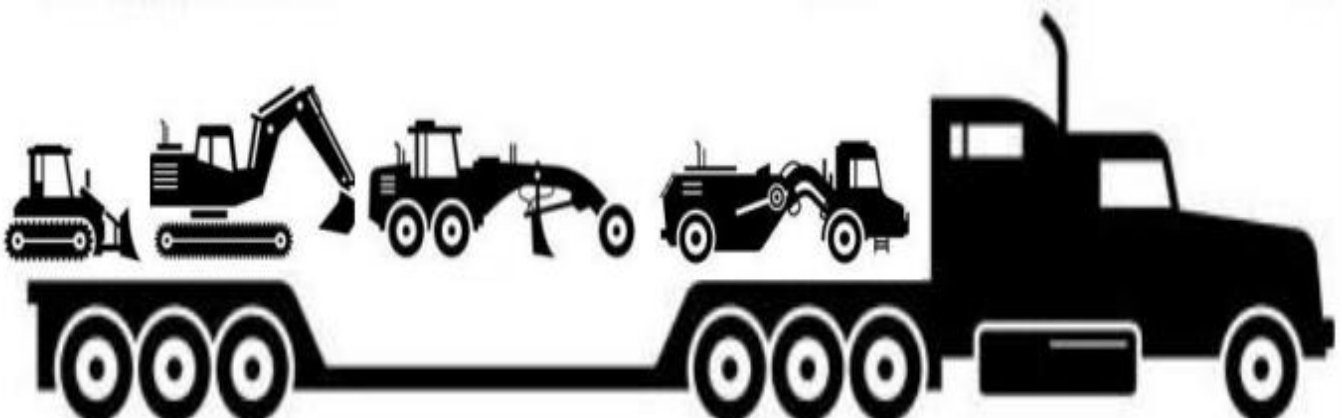
