A MEETING TO FORM THE GROUP - FRIENDS OF THE LISMORE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

The Lismore Presbyterian church is now closed for services and for weddings, funerals, etc and is likely to be put up for sale in 2027 by the regional Presbytery. An approach has been made to the Presbytery that a Lismore group is being formed able to take over the management and ongoing preservation of this historic church, to have the building regularly open for educational, cultural, and other positive purposes. This might be talks - including under U3A, choir or musical activities, writers' workshops, and organising events related to our local history or forgotten crafts of the region (stonemasonry, working bluestone, producing flax).

A meeting to start formation of the Friends group will be held in a few weeks, with the place, day and time to be advised (likely the Lismore CFA building, around mid-August, late afternoon and not a Wednesday). There is already a group of 8-10 keen people, with some only able to attend on-line.

How to deal with loud weekend noise about town?

The rural peace and quiet of some nights recently has been shattered by loud music and motorcycle races by rowdy weekenders from out of town.

What can we do about it? We are told that the best thing to do to lodge a noise complaint is to call 000.

It might seem extreme but it's the best way to log the issue and get a prompt police response.

Police will attend when they can as a result of the 000 call and, if deemed to be unreasonable, demand that the noise be abated. If the noise continues to be unreasonable then the rowdy ones face heavy penalties under EPA provisions.

FIRE RECOVERY ACTIONS

Corangamite Shire Fire Recovery Officers have worked with community organisations to form a LarraLea Community Recovery Group. An action out of their first meeting is to distribute a community survey to guide future actions. The survey will be out later this month and community responses will be helpful.

Corangamite Shire Community Funding: At its July meeting the Shire Council approved and announced 86 grants across the Shire totalling \$320,000 across four grant programs. The detailed information can be viewed in the media release on the shire website. These included Lismore Land Protection Group (\$1,400) towards an educational bus trip, and \$1,290 for its night stalk; The Corangamite Film Society (\$2000) for a six day Iranian Film Festival (Lismore Progress Association intends to support this), Murnong Indigenous Garden (\$20,850) for pathways and ramps to improve access to the garden, toilets and meeting room on what was the old croquet green (See site diagram below):
