- At the same time, the closest available ambulance responds, with the fire brigade also sent in some parts of Victoria.
- 4 The first on scene can provide CPR and, if possible, use a defibrillator.

01	Take a picture of your photo ID on your phone
02	Download the 'GoodSAM Responder' app
03	Select 'Register with Email' and fill in personal information including user name and password
04	Under Organisation, select 'Australia: Public'
05	Under Occupation, select 'Other'
06	Under Registration Body and Registration No. type 'N/A'
07	Press the 'SELECT DOCUMENT' button and upload a picture of the photo ID
08	Leave Expiry Date as today's date
09	Select 'Register', then check your email for a verification email (check junk and spam) and click link to confirm
10	Once your ID is verified by GoodSAM, you'll receive a notification email to log into the app. Now you're ready to save a life!
