September in the Garden

A to do list for some of the gardeners amongst us:

- * Plant seeds direct into the ground: Carrots, beetroot, radish, peas, spinach, rocket, and Asian greens like bok choy.
- * As seedlings (punnets): Lettuce, silverbeet, kale, broccoli, cabbage, and cauliflower.
- * Warm-weather crops (protected indoors or with a heat mat): Start Tomatoes, capsicums, chillies, eggplants, cucumbers, and zucchini
- * Herbs: Coriander, dill, parsley, chives, and perennial herbs like mint, thyme, and rosemary.
- * Fruit & Perennials: Plant strawberry runners, rhubarb crowns, and asparagus

Prepare the Soil:

- * Dig in plenty of aged compost and organic matter to feed your upcoming spring and summer crops.
- * Apply Mulch: Spread a fresh layer of organic mulch around existing plants to suppress weeds and lock in soil moisture.

Control Pests:

- * Keep an eye out for emerging slugs and snails active in the damp spring weather

Don't forget to grab a cuppa and enjoy the small glimpses of sunshine we are starting to see!

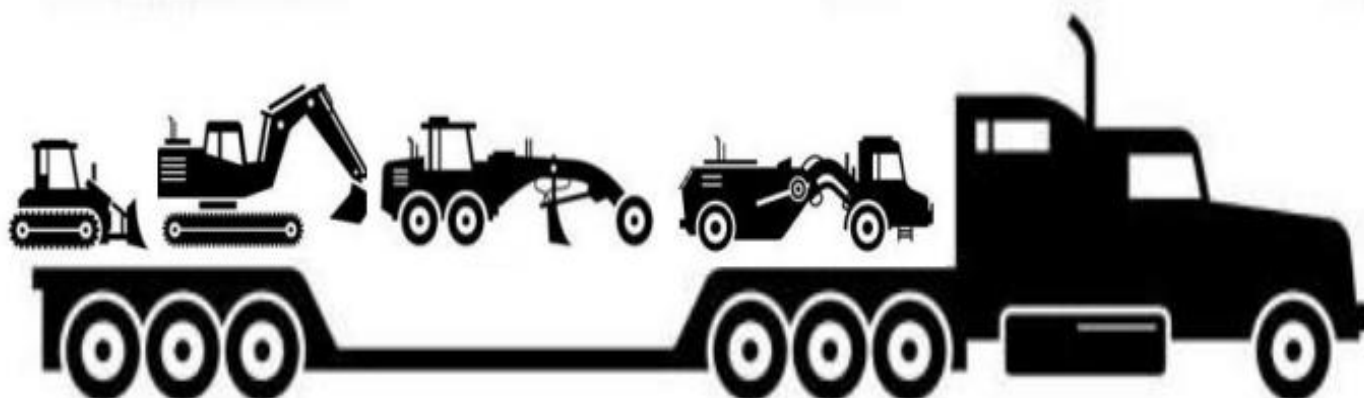
